ABOUT THE PLACE

Experience the majestic beauty of Ladakh with this 10-day Leh Ladakh tour package that takes you on a journey through some of the most breathtaking landscapes in the world. Starting from Srinagar, the capital of Jammu and Kashmir, the tour takes you to Kargil, Leh, Nubra, Pangong, Sarchu, and Manali before concluding in Delhi.

The trip begins with a local sightseeing tour of Srinagar, followed by a visit to Kargil, famous for its role in the India-Pakistan war. From there, the journey proceeds towards Leh, the capital city of Ladakh, where you will explore popular attractions like Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, Magnetic Hill, and Sangam.

The tour then takes you to Nubra Valley, a picturesque region known for its sand dunes and lush greenery. You will also visit Turtuk, a remote village located close to the Pakistan border that has recently been opened to tourists. From there, the journey continues to Pangong Tso, a serene high-altitude lake that changes color throughout the day, before heading back to Leh.

The final leg of the tour takes you through Sarchu and Manali, two popular tourist destinations in Himachal Pradesh, before

Arrival At Srinagar - Overnight Stay At Srinagar

- Arrive at Srinagar Airport and reach the houseboat.
- Upon reaching the houseboat, you'll be greeted by our team captain.
- Check in to the houseboat, freshen up, and relax. You can go for Shikara Ride.
- You can explore the Srinagar market for some shopping.
- Briefing for the next day & overnight sleep.





Srinagar To Kargil Via Sonamarg, Drass & Zojila Pass. [Distance: 200km, Duration: 8-9 Hours] - Overnight Stay At Kargil.

- Wake up early morning and post breakfast depart for Kargil [2700m].
- Enroute cross Sonamarg.
- Then head towards Drass, the coldest inhabited place in India & often called Gateway to Ladakh, via the Zoji La Pass [3528m].
- After the lunch break, continue your journey to Kargil.
- Arrive at Kargil & check in to the hotel.





Kargil To Leh Via Namika La & Fotu La. [Distance: 230km, Duration: 7-8 Hours] - Overnight Stay At Leh.

- Wake up early morning & post breakfast start your journey to Leh[3500m].
- Drive from Kargil to Lamayuru via Mulbek, Namika La [3700m] and Fotu La [4108m].
- From Lamayuru, Leh is approximately 125km that passes through Hangroo Loops and Nimmu.
- Reach Leh by evening & check in to the hotel.
- Dinner & Sleep Overnight.





Leh To Nubra Valley Via Khardung La. [Distance: 125km, Duration: 5-6 Hours] - Overnight Stay At Diskit.

- After breakfast in the morning, head to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La (One of the highest motorable roads at 5359 mt).
- On the way to Nubra Valley first visit Shanti Stupa and start your journey back to Nubra Valley [3000m].
- Nubra Valley is popularly known as Ldorma or the Valley of Flowers.
- It is situated to the north of Ladakh between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of the Himalayas.
- Check in to the hotel and visit the Sand Dunes cold deserts of India(Hunder), and take a camel safari (self-paid).
- · Visit the Diskit village and the Monastery around.





Nubra Valley To Turtuk To Nubra Valley. [Distance: 200km, Duration: 7-8 Hours]- Overnight Stay At Diskit.

- Wake up to a beautiful sunrise.
- Post breakfast departs for Turtuk [2820m], a remote village of about 4,000 residents inhabited by ethnic Muslims.
- Spend some time in the pristine landscapes of Turtuk Village.
- Come back to Diskit by evening.
- Dinner & Sleep Overnight.





Nubra Valley To Pangong Tso Via Shyok Valley. [Distance: 160 Km, Duration: 5-6 Hours]- Overnight Stay At Pangong Tso

- After breakfast check out, and start your journey to the famous Pangong Tso [4350m] via the Agam and Shyok villages.
- Pangong Tso which is perhaps one of the most amazing lakes in Asia changes its color 4 5 times a day.
- The Pangong Lake or "Lake of the great hollow" is considered the world's highest saltwater lake.
- At an elevation of 4300 meters, the air is cool even in summer at Ladakh. Pangong Lake is about 4 km wide on average and at least 136 Km long. The extent of the known portion is, therefore, upwards of 250 square miles (400 sq. km).
- Reach Pangong Lake & check in to the campsite. Dinner & sleep overnight.





Pangong Tso To Leh Via Chang La. [Distance: 160km, Duration: 5-6 Hours] - Overnight Stay At Leh

- Wake up early morning to witness a mesmerizing sunrise.
- After having breakfast, head back to Leh.
- En route visit Chang-La, one of the highest motorable roads in the world at 5350 m.
- Reach by evening time and explore the local market/cafe's since it will the last day in Leh.
- Shop something for your friends/relatives back home.
- Come back to the hotel by evening. Dinner and sleep overnight





Leh To Sarchu Via Moore Plains. [Distance: 260km, Duration: 8-9 Hours]. Overnight Stay In Sarchu.

- Wake Up & make an early start to the day.
- Depart for an exciting journey across the Leh-Manali highway.
- Today first you'll witness a flattened straight road about 35km long at Moore Plains.
- After lunch at Pang, we'll encounter Lachung La(5065m) & Nakee La(4739m).
- Just before Sarchu, we'll be greeted by Gata Loops(21 hairpin bends at 4669m).
- Reach Sarchu & check in to the camps.
- Dinner & sleep overnight under million stars.





Sarchu To Manali Via Atal Tunnel. [Distance: 175km, Duration: 5-6 Hours] - Overnight Stay At Manali.

- Wake up early morning & depart for the long ride post breakfast.
- Drive over Baralacha-La(4892 m) which is one of the most challenging passes among other passes on Leh Manali Highway, & offers breathtaking panoramic views.
- Just on top of Baralacha La is a small lake Suraj Tal.
- Drive through Zingzing Bar, Patsio, and Darcha to reach Manali.
- Check-in at the hotel. Dinner & Sleep Overnight.





Relaxing Day In Manali | Self Exploration- Departure For Delhi.

- Wake up lazy and post breakfast you can head out for local sightseeing in Manali.
- Places you can visit Hidimba Devi Temple, Jogni Waterfall, Vashisht Temple, Mall Road (On your own).
- Spend some time in the magical streets of Old Manali, cafe hopping.
- Depart for Delhi by evening.
- Reach Delhi by morning with amazing trip memories.
